The U.S. Department of State's [Gilman Scholarship Program](#) is an undergraduate grant program that provides awards of up to \$5,000 for students who are U.S. citizens, Federal Pell Grant recipients, and undergraduate students who will be studying abroad for a minimum of 21 days.
